

Saint Luke School's Wiggles and Giggles program (formerly Mommy and Me) is a once weekly, interactive program for caregivers and children from birth through Age 4. Families will grow, learn, explore, laugh, move, and connect together. The program is taught by an experienced early childhood teacher and an assistant, along with parent volunteers. Please see requirements, fees, and registration information below.

Wiggles and Giggles Information

- Program is for children ages birth through 4 years old .
 - An adult caregiver must accompany the child.
- Adult caregivers must be vaccinated against Covid 19 and be Virtus trained (a class will be offered in the fall for those who need the training).
- Classes are held once per week on Wednesdays from 9 am until 10:30 am in the Saint Luke School Gym.
 - The program runs from late September through early June.
 - Diaper changing facilities are available, however there are no bathroom facilities for adults.
 - Pre-payment is required through the purchase of attendance ("punch")
 cards. These cards cover 10 sessions and can be used at any time
 throughout the year. Additional cards can be purchased, when needed.
- Each card for 10 sessions for one child is \$100. Cards for 10 sessions for two children are \$150.
 - Cards can be picked up at the first session.
- A one time registration form can be filled out in advance of the first session or at the first session. This must be included, along with a copy of the Covid vaccine card for the adult attending as well as a copy of the Virtus certificate for the adult attending.

- Small, pre-packaged snacks and water will be provided for children. If your child has allergies, we suggest you bring your own snacks, if needed.
 - Program calendar will be distributed at the first session.
